



**AIRSTRIP AWARDED GROUP PURCHASING AGREEMENT WITH PREMIER**  
*Top healthcare purchasing network enters arrangement with  
remote healthcare surveillance innovator to increase availability of AirStrip OB™*

**SAN ANTONIO – June 23, 2009** - AirStrip Technologies™, L.P., a leader in the field of remote healthcare surveillance, today announced it has signed an agreement with Premier Purchasing Partners L.P., the group purchasing unit of Premier Inc., one of the nation's largest healthcare purchasing networks. Terms of the agreement were not disclosed.

The centerpiece of the agreement is AirStrip's signature product, AirStrip OB, which is now in use in nearly 100 hospitals across the U.S. AirStrip OB delivers vital patient waveform data - including fetal heartbeat and maternal contraction patterns - in virtual real-time directly from the hospital labor and delivery unit to a doctor's smart phone from anywhere the doctor gets a cell-phone connection. This application can improve patient safety, giving the physician the ability to closely monitor his or her patients 24/7, even without being bedside.

Premier serves more than 2,100 U.S. hospitals and 58,000-plus other healthcare sites. Its services include providing group contracting for hospital products and services, consulting solutions, and insurance management. Nearly 200 not-for-profit hospitals and health systems own the Premier alliance.

"The core purpose of Premier is to improve the health of communities, and we see great alignment with our AirStrip Technologies remote healthcare surveillance solution to help deliver measurable improvements in care throughout the Premier membership," AirStrip co-founder and Chief Medical Officer Dr. Cameron Powell said.

The AirStrip platform works in tandem with existing in-hospital patient monitoring systems, securely sending that data directly to the doctor's mobile device - while protecting that information with the strictest security solutions and HIPAA compliance standards. The hospital is required to acquire an AirStrip server, and the AirStrip application is provided to doctors on a subscription basis. Subscriptions are purchased by the hospital for the physicians.

News of the agreement with Premier comes soon after AirStrip Technologies received an opportunity to present its current and in-development applications for the iPhone as part of Apple's annual Worldwide Developers Conference (WWDC), one of the most closely-watched tech conferences in the world.

While at the WWDC, AirStrip's co-founders, Dr. Powell and Trey Moore, took to the stage at Apple's invitation to present a live demo of the forthcoming AirStrip CRITICAL CARE™ application for the iPhone. AirStrip Technologies will seek U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) clearance for the CRITICAL CARE application this year.

A free demo version of AirStrip OB on the iPhone can be downloaded at the Apple App Store. AirStrip OB is also available for use on the BlackBerry and a variety of Windows Mobile smart phones.
